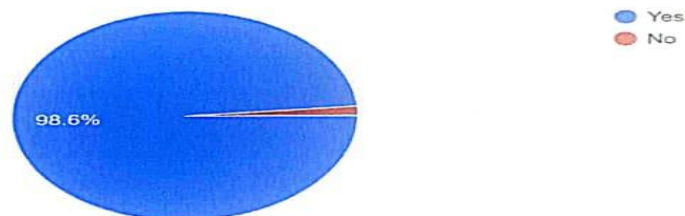

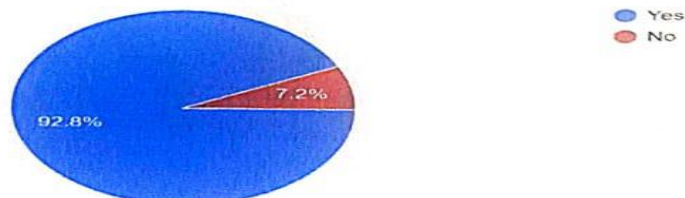

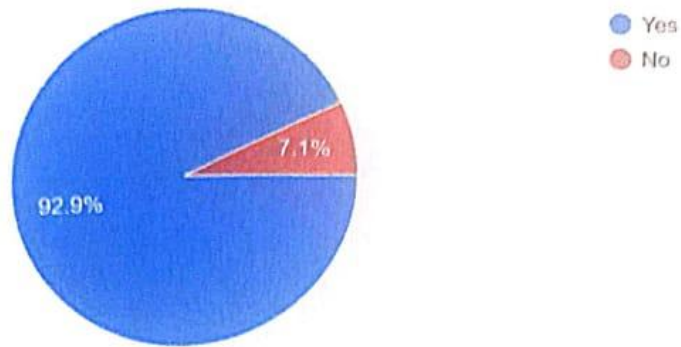


2. Should governments create more jobs to reduce poverty?

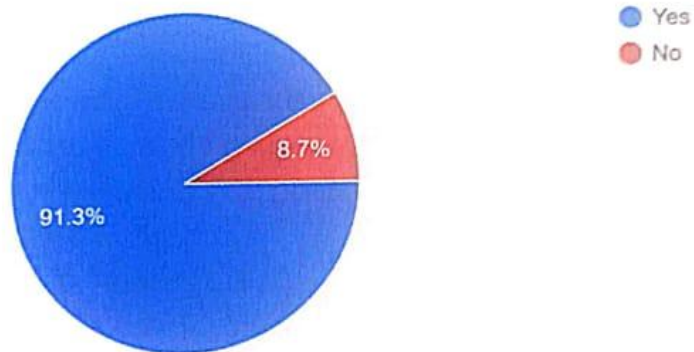
3. Is affordable healthcare necessary to fight poverty?

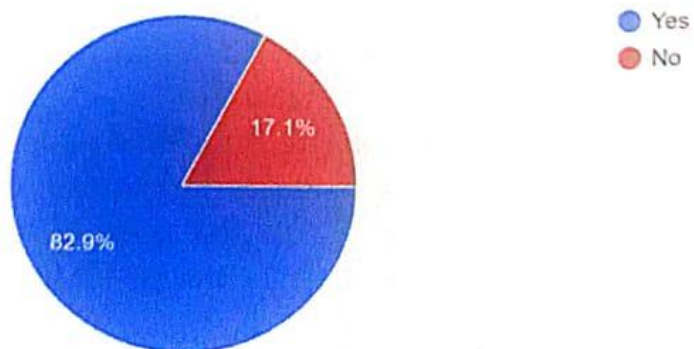
4. Do you think providing food assistance helps those in need?

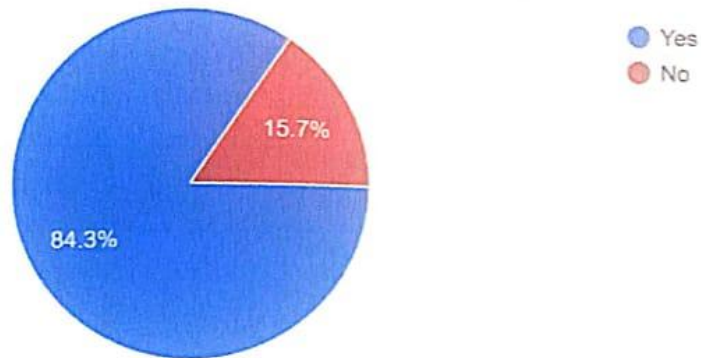

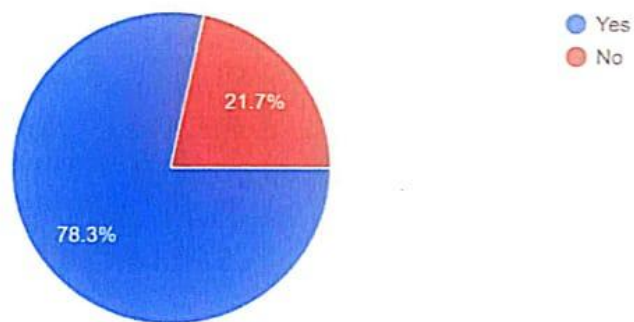

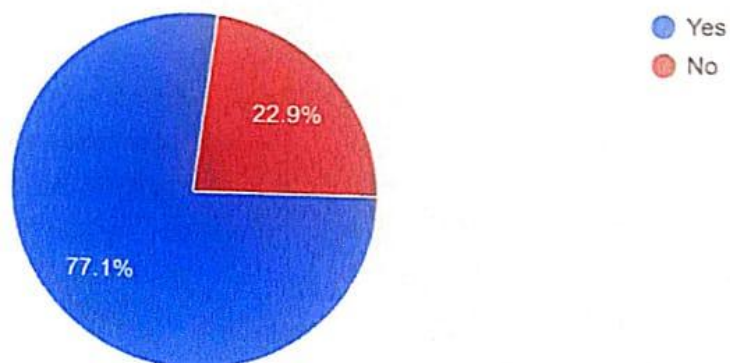
