






















































## **Analysis and Action Taken Report (ATR)**

1) **Analysis**: - About 66.4% of the students gave their response that 85% - 100% syllabus was covered and 21.4% of the students opined that 70% - 84% syllabus was covered, but 2% of the students are dissatisfied with poor syllabus coverage.

**ATR**: - Enquired the details of less percentage of syllabus coverage and gave counseling to concerned teacher.

2) **Analysis**: 96.5 % of the students expressed that their teachers prepare thoroughly and satisfactorily for the classes, but 1% of the students did not satisfy their teachers' preparation for the classes.

**ATR:** - A general meeting was conducted to the teachers who are going to classes without sufficient preparation and suggested them to prepare well.

3) **Analysis**: 94.7 % of the students gave their response that their teachers' ability to communication is impressive, but 1.2 % of the students said that their teachers' communication is poor.

ATR: Suggested the faculty to improve communication skills.

4) **Analysis**: About 82.5% of the students expressed that their teachers' approach to teaching was excellent and very good, but 0.5 % students said that their teachers' approach to teaching was poor.

**ATR**: Counseled the teachers to improve their teaching skills by attending FDP/RC/OCs especially on "Teaching Methodologies".

5) **Analysis**: About 86% of the students gave their response that the evaluation process by the teachers was always and usually fair, but only 0.9% of the students are dissatisfied with evaluation process.

**ATR**: Directed the students to raise an issue in grievance cell and advised the teachers to evaluate the answer scripts carefully.

6) **Analysis**: 86.9% of the students opined that usually and every time their teachers discuss their performance in assignments, but only 1.1% of the students said that their performance in assignments was not discussed with them.

ATR: Advice teachers to discuss with the students about the mistakes committed by him/her in presenting assignment.

7) **Analysis**: 85.2% of the students expressed that their institute takes active interest regularly and often in promoting internship, students exchange etc, but only 0.9% of the students said that they are dissatisfied about this.

**ATR**: Planned to arrange more number of field trips, if possible at least one field trip from each department. Advised faculty to think about students exchange program in next year.

8) **Analysis**: About 93.15% of the students gave their response that teaching and mentoring process in the institution helps in cognitive, social and emotional growth significantly and very well, but 1.2 % of the students are dissatisfied about this.

**ATR**: The staff members are advised to mentor their wards with utmost care.

9) **Analysis**: About 89.8% of the students opined positively regarding their institution provides multiple opportunities to grow, but only 1% of the students are not agree with this.

ATR: Planning to introduce certificate/ add on courses in the coming year.

10) **Analysis**: About 91% of the students expressed that their teachers inform them every time and usually about expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes, but only 0.6% of the students are not agree with this.

**ATR:** Display the Course Outcomes and Programme outcomes on the notice board, and also a special class can be taken to newly admitted students regarding this.

11) **Analysis**: 91.8% of the students expressed that every time and usually their mentors take necessary follow-up with an assigned task to them, but only 1.6% of the students are dissatisfied about this.

**ATR:** Given suggestions to the mentors to monitor the student regularly.

12) **Analysis**: 93.4% of the students opined that every time and usually their teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications, but only 1.70 % students were dissatisfied about this.

**ATR**: Suggested faculty to explain the concepts with more illustrations.

13) **Analysis**: About 90.80 % of the students gave positive response regarding their teachers in identifying their strengths and encouraging them with providing right level of challenges, but 1.1% of the students are unable to say.

**ATR:** Suggested teachers to identify strengths of all students.

14) **Analysis**: 92.2% of the students had positive opinion regarding their teachers in identifying their weaknesses and helping them to overcome, but 1.5% of the students are not happy regarding this.

ATR: Suggested teachers to identify the weakness of the students and to encourage them to overcome.

15) **Analysis:** 95.8% of the students gave positive response regarding their involvement in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

**ATR:** Suggested facility to continue the involvement of students.

16) **Analysis:** 92.5% of students opined that their teachers use student centric methods to a great extent and moderately, but 0.6% of the students gave response as not at all.

ATR: Suggested faculty to introduce innovative teaching methods for the benefit of the students

17) **Analysis:** About 64.8% students strongly agreed that their teachers encourage them in participating extra - curricular activities and 27.2% of the students agreed that their teachers encourage them in participating extra - curricular activities but 0.3% of students gave response as "Strongly Disagree".

**ATR:** Suggested faculty to motivate students to participate in extracurricular activities and explain them the importance of these type of achievements in their career.

18) **Analysis:** 91.6% of the students gave positive response regarding the efforts of their institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work, but 0.9% of the students did not satisfy regarding this.

**ATR**: suggested English faculty to take more number of classes for developing soft skills if possible in zero hours or else online classes.

19) **Analysis:** 46.6% of the students expressed that more than 90% of their teachers are using ICT tools while teaching, 32.5% of the students opined that more than 70% - 89% of their teachers are using ICT tools while teaching, but 1.4% of the students gave their response that less than 29% of the teachers are using ICT tools.

ATR: Suggested faculty to adopt latest ICT tools for teachers like Blog, Nearpod, Kahoot etc.,

20) **Analysis:** 90.7% of the students opined positively on the overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institute, but only 1.2% of the students are not satisfied on this aspect.

**ATR:** Suggested the faculty to sustain the overall teaching - learning process and take initiation wherever necessary.
