Report on Photo and Stamp Exhibition on 04.7.2022

The Department of History organized Photo and Stamp Exhibition programme on the occasion of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav and 125th Birth Anniversary of Alluri Sita Rama Raju on 04.7.2022.

Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav is an initiative of the Government of India to celebrate and commemorate 75 years of independence of progressive India and the glorious history of its people, culture, and achievements.

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' by flagging off 'Dandi March' from Sabarmati Ashram, Ahmedabad on 12th March 2021.

One of the main motives of the Amrit Mahotsav is that every citizen of India should know about all the untold incidents of the freedom struggle. The Azadi Mahotsav involves a countrywide campaign that focuses on citizen participation.

The statue was unveiled to mark the 125th birth anniversary of Alluri Sitarama Raju. It is a 15-tonne statue and was carved out at the cost of Rs 3 crore. It has been installed by Kshatriya Seva Samiti in Municipal Park at ASR Nagar in Bhimavaram. Statue was installed as part of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrations.

On this occasion the Department of History arranged Freedom Fighters Photos and Stamp Exhibition in collaboration with Postal Department of Avanigadda, Sri Ramalingeswara Rao, Head post master. Our principal Dr. D. Uma Rani inaugurated the programme.

Around 250 members from Faculty, Students and local people were actively participated in Exhibition and very interestingly observed Stamps issued by postal department on Freedom fighters and collected stamps from Foreign countries.
