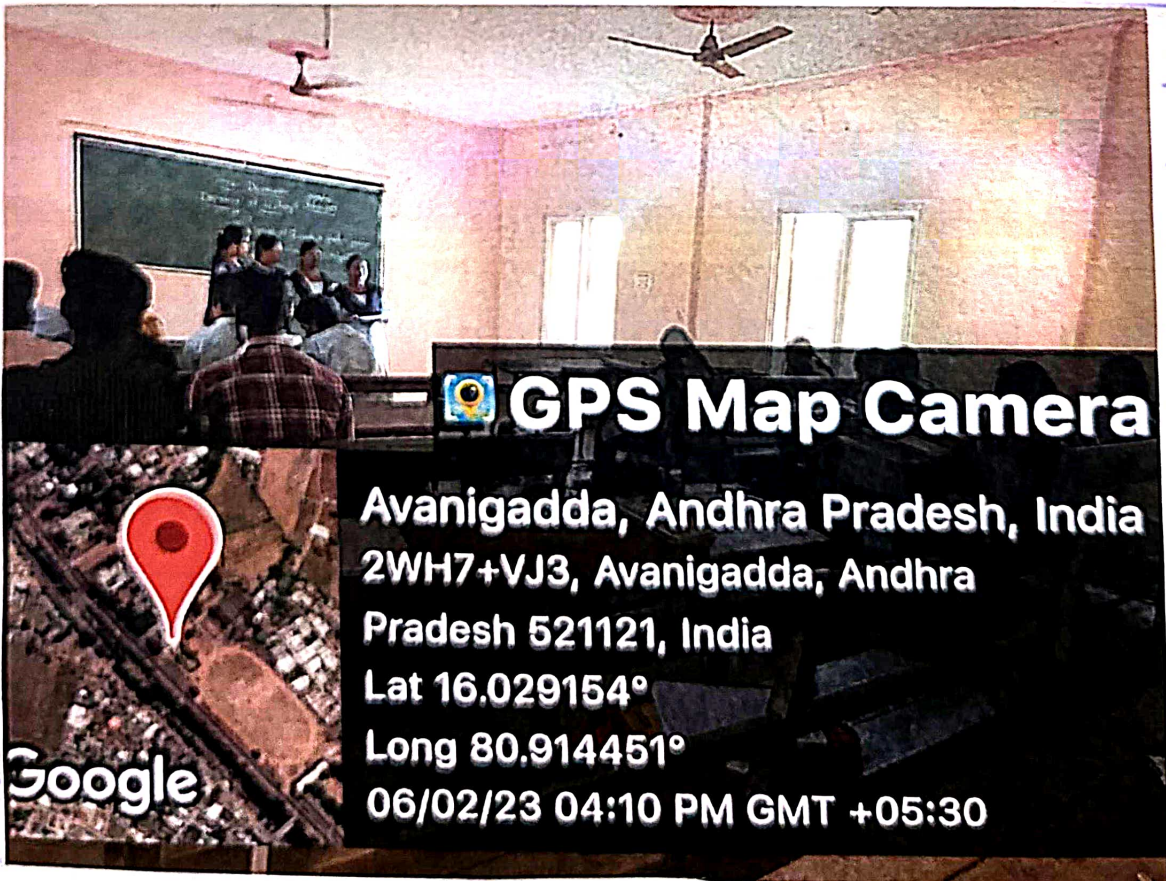

1. The Borra caves in the Ananthagiri Hills of the Eastern Ghats, near Visakhapatnam at an altitude about 800 to 1300 metres are famous for million year-old stalactite and stalagmite formations.
