



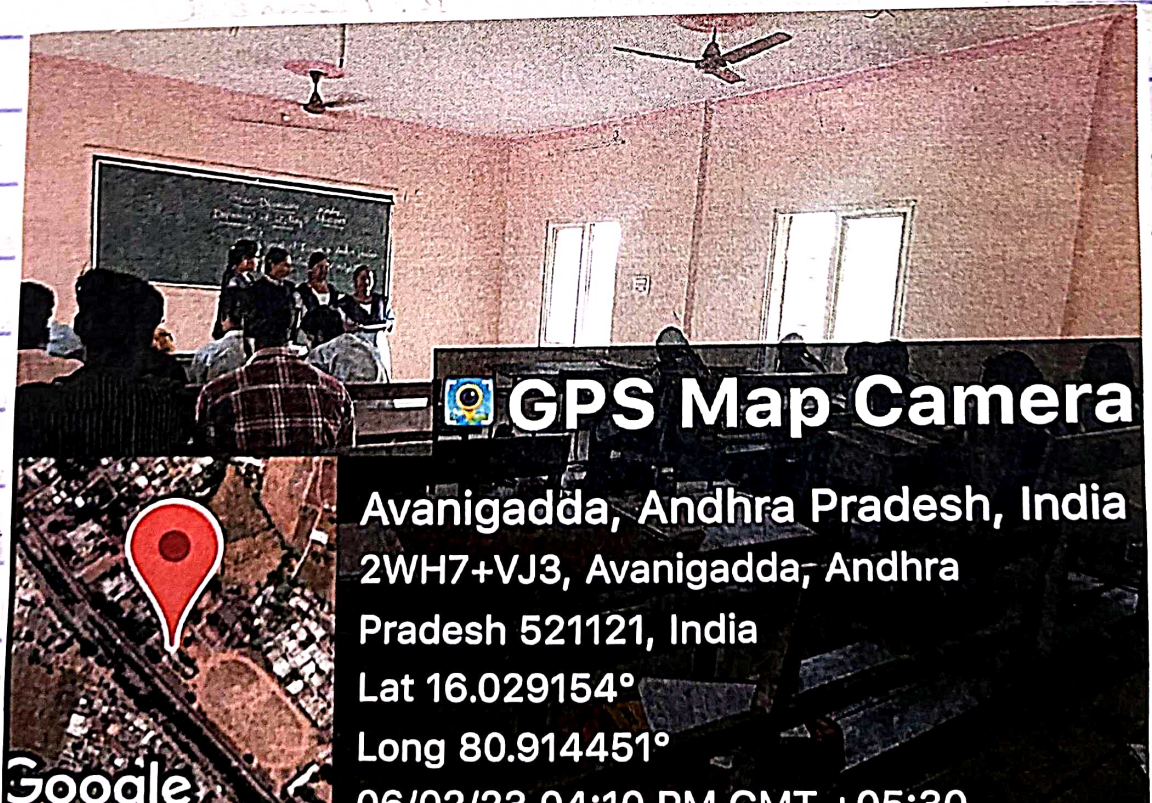

1. Gandhi's ideology of non-violence and Satyagraha - has changed the course of the national movement in a different direction.
2. He led a non-violent civil disobedience movement against the Britisher's injustice meted at the Indians
3. Gandhi led peaceful campaigns to expand women's rights, ease poverty, end untouchability, build ethnic and religious amity, and achieve Swaraj.
4. Gandhi's vision of an Independent India based on religious pluralism was challenged in the early 1940s by the muslim nationalism which demanded a separate homeland for muslims within British India.
5. Gandhi dedicated his life to discovering and pursuing truth, or Satya, and called his movement Satyagraha, which means "appeal to insistence on, or reliance on the truth".

1. Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi was an Indian lawyer, anti colonial nationalist and political ethicist who employed non-violent resistance to lead the successful campaign for India's independence from British rule.

2. Born and raised in a hindu family in Coastal Gujarat, Gandhi trained in the law at the Inner Temple, London, and was called to the bar at age 22 in June 1891.

3. Assuming leadership of the Indian national Congress in 1921, Gandhi led nation wide campaigns for easing poverty, expanding women's rights, building religious and ethnic amity, ending untouchability, and, above all, achieving swaraj or self-rule.

4. Gandhiji provided a rock solid second rung leadership to national freedom struggle.
